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## LMTA Foundation Reveals 2023 Louisiana Fleet Safety Award Winners

The 19 companies with outstanding safety records are now eligible for two grand prizes to be announced during the Louisiana Trucking Safety Awards on March 4

**Baton Rouge, La.** — **February 14, 2023** — The LMTA Foundation, in partnership with Great West Casualty Company, named 19 division winners in the 2023 Louisiana Fleet Safety Awards. These awards stress the importance of safety, recognize professionalism, and focus on the principles behind safe driving programs, according to the LMTA.
